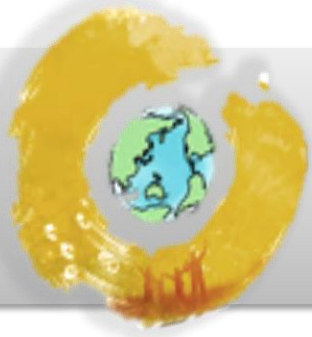
Programme at a glance
