

**The 3rd Regional Workshop of GHSA Detect 1
[National Laboratory System]
“GHSA 2024: Advancing Collaborative Efforts Across
Relevant GHSA Action Packages”
16-18 January 2019, Bangkok, Thailand**

Co-Hosts By: The Department of Medical Sciences, Ministry of Public Health, Thailand and the Department of Livestock Development, Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Thailand

A: BACKGROUND

1. As one of the lead countries of Detect 1, the Department of Medical Sciences [DMSC] has taken the lead in organizing the two consecutive regional Workshops in July 2016 and February 2017 respectively. To maintain the momentum of joint collaborative efforts among lead countries, contributing countries, key development partners, the 3rd Regional Workshop will be convened during 16-18 January 2019.
2. This activity is one of a series of regional activities supported by the USAID through the Letter of Agreement made between the FAO and the DMSC, the regional platform will entail an accelerating of an implementation of the LSS [2016 – 2020], enhancing collaboration particularly among relevant Action Packages, intensifying existing networking, and sharing experiences for better lab preparedness.
3. The 3rd Regional Workshop of Detect 1 will take stock of the results and needed follow up actions of two consecutive GHSA Detect 1 Regional Workshops in July 2016 and February 2017 as well as the joint Workshop of Detect 1 and Detect 5 in February 2018.
4. Based on internal consultation meeting and the 2/2018 video conference of Detect 1, it is agreed that the Workshop will address the following objectives:
 - Updating on GHSA Post 2018 and beyond;
 - Emphasizing on collaboration with other Action Packages, especially AMR, Zoonotic Disease and Biosafety and Biosecurity;
 - Follow up on D1 roadmap implementation; and

- Follow up on relevant outputs of the D1 & D5 Workshop which was jointly held in February 2018.
5. It is expected of more than 100 participants (self-supported & supported) representing animal health and human health sectors from ASEAN and SAARC countries, other relevant GHSA Action Packages such as zoonotic, Workforce Development, AMR, Bio Security & Bio Safety, Real – Time Surveillance as well as key development partners.

B: OBJECTIVES

6. The 3 – Day Workshop aims for the following:
- 1) Updates on GHSA 2024;
 - 2) Follow up on D1 Roadmap Implementation;
 - 3) Follow up on the outputs of the D1 & D5 Workshop;
 - 4) Exploring possible collaboration with other Action Packages; and
 - 5) Enhancing Networking.

C: PARTICIPANT AND LOGISTIC ARRANGEMENT

7. It is expected for 100 - 120 representatives as detailed below.

 - e) Chair/representative of GHSA Steering Committee [2 pp]
 - f) International development partners and Regional Organizations including Development partners [SEARO, WPRO, FAO HQ, WHO Lyon, OIE, GPP, DTRA, ASEAN

Secretariat [AH & HH], US CDC, World Bank, USAID, CBEP, JICA, ASEAN, SAARC[self-supported,10 - 15 pp]

- g) Local partners and governmental agencies including Permanent Secretary, Deputy Permanent Secretary, Director General of Department of Communicable Diseases, Bureau of Epidemiology, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), Live Stock, NIH Animal, US Thai CDC, AFRIM, and others [self-supported, 10 pp]
- h) Other honour guests, speakers and resource person = [supported by invitation only, 6 pp]
- i) Other interested members countries[self-supported, 3-5 pp],
- j) Organizing Committee [the DMSC and DLD]

13. Full support including round trip of direct economy airfare, accommodation, meeting packages will be provided for;

- a) Representatives from ASIA Pacific countries including ASEAN, SAARC, and Timor Leste [2 persons from each of Member States representing animal health lab and human health lab, 36 pp]; and
