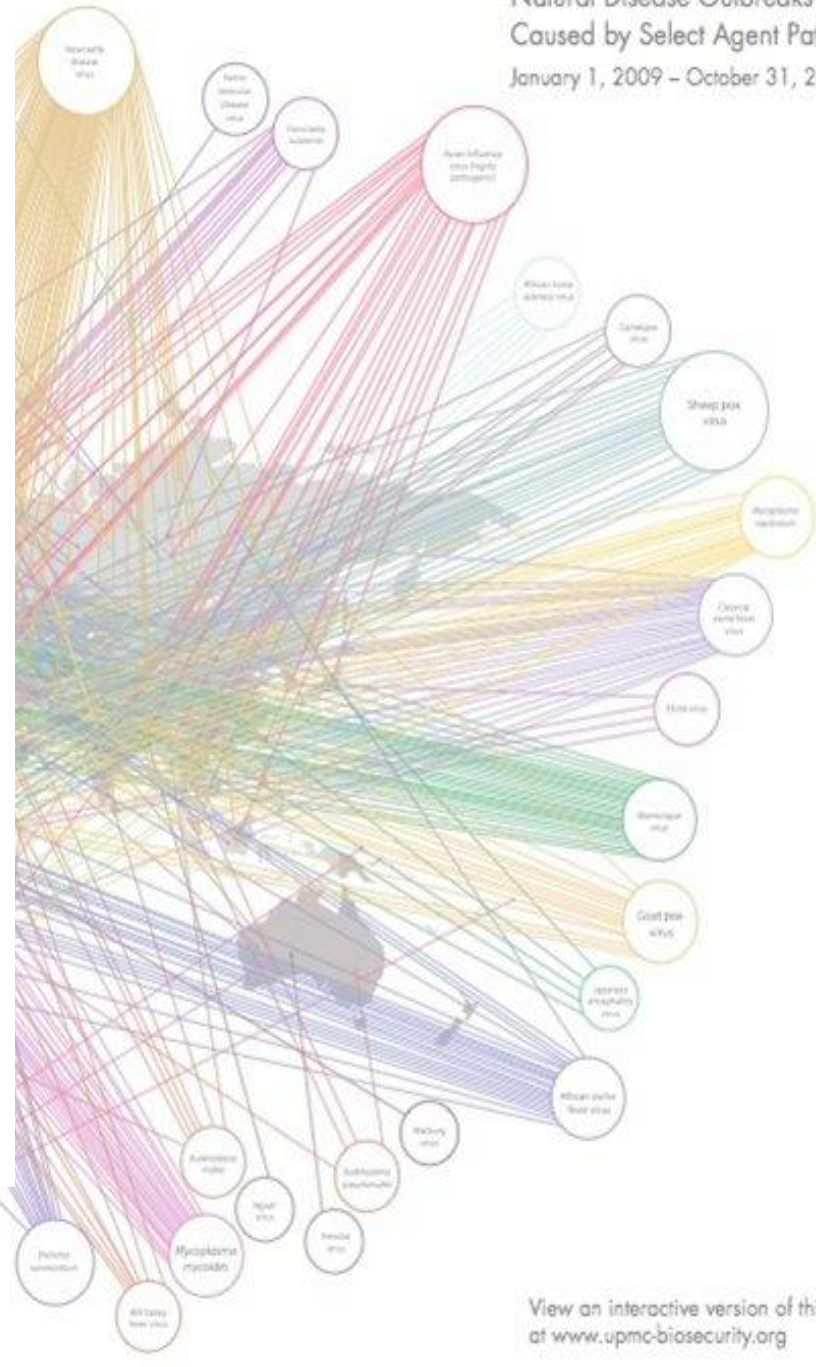




# GHSAC

The Global Health Security Agenda Consortium



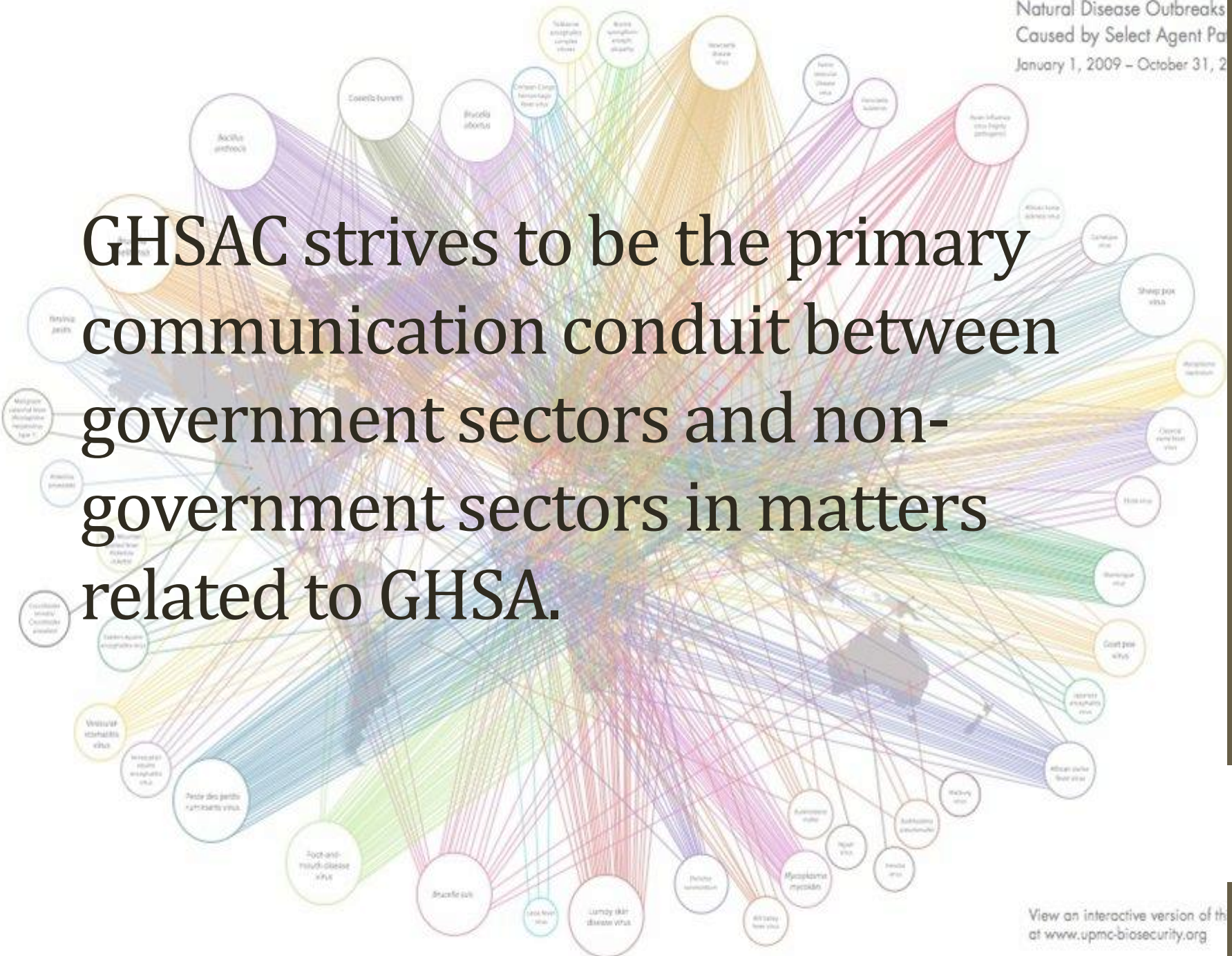

Organized shortly after the GHSA launch in 2014, membership in GHSAC is open to public and private entities committed to the advocacy, implementation and success of the GHSA.



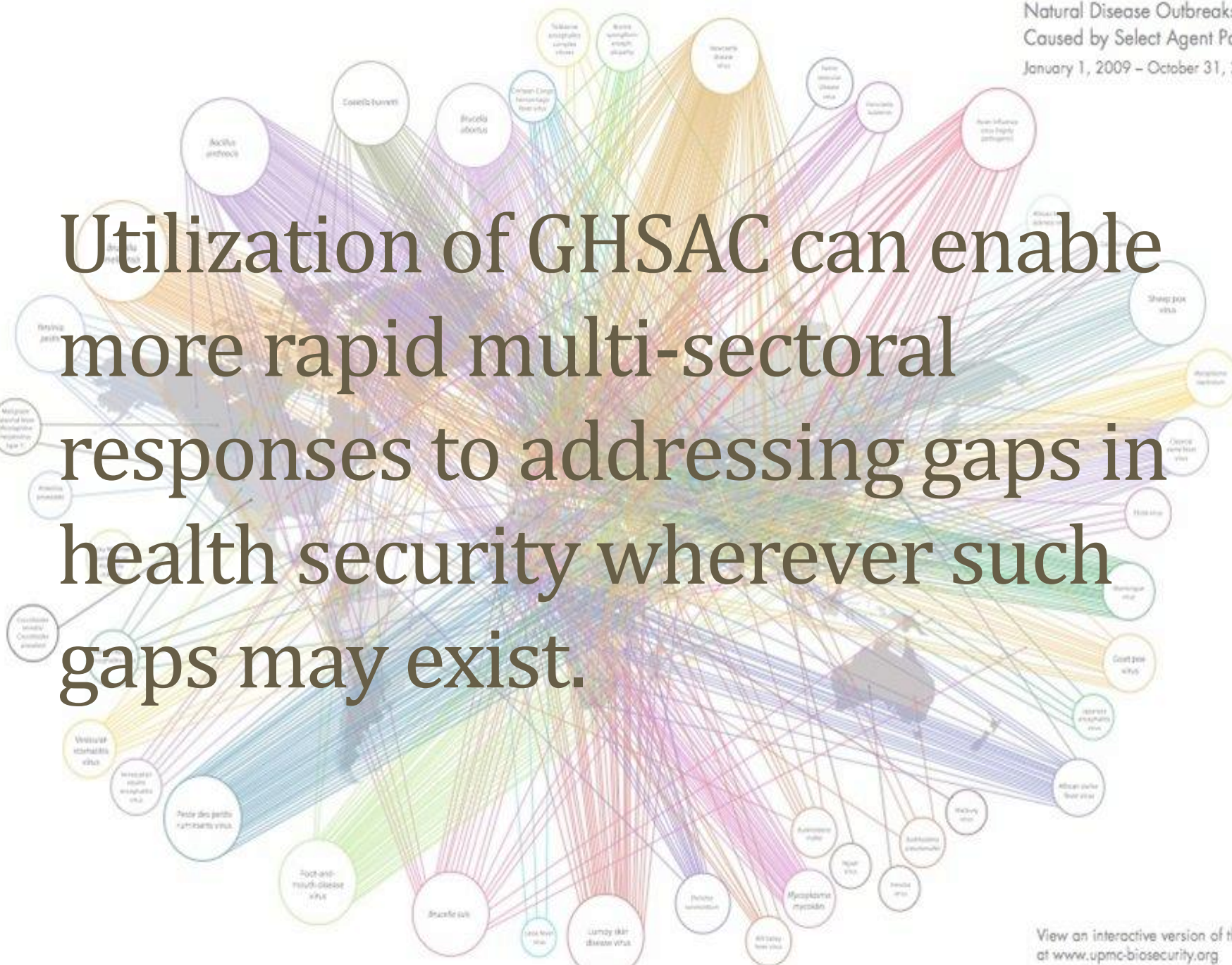
GHSAC strives to be the primary communication conduit between government sectors and non-government sectors in matters related to GHSA.
