Background

- Many countries, international organizations, and representatives from the non-governmental sector have made national, regional, and global commitments in support of GHSA and to advance implementation of IHR and other multisectoral health security efforts since launch of GHSA
- Tracking these commitments is critical to strengthen capacities to prevent, detect, and respond to infectious diseases and other acute health threats.

Objectives

- To create a mechanism to coordinate commitments made by each country and track progress and outcomes,
 - To offer an opportunity to publicize all commitments and outcomes
 - To provide a platform to engage with all 55 GHSA countries and other nations that have made commitments
 - To promote transparency among partners.
 - To demonstrate the impact of GHSA on health security by tracking commitments and outcomes .

Three types of Commitments

- National commitments
 - Countries to strengthen their own domestic health security capacities.
 - Commitments:
 - undergoing JEE,
 - developing a post-JEE multi-year national action plan,
 - implementation work to strengthen specific capacities.

Three types of Commitments

- Assistance commitments
 - International partners (countries, international organizations, non-governmental stakeholders, etc.) to support countries in strengthening their own domestic health security capacities through the provision of funding, technical resources, or both.
 - Commitments:
 - supporting countries to undergo JEE,
 - supporting countries to develop post-JEE multi-year national action plans,
 - supporting countries to implementation work to strengthen specific capacities.

Three types of Commitments

- Global/regional leadership commitments
 - Activities demonstrating clear global or regional leadership to advance health security goals
 - Commitments:
 - hosting major meetings or leading regional or global organizations committed to supporting and advancing IHR implementation and achieving the goals of the GHSA.

Collect and publish

- Under the SG Chair's discretion and direction
 - Data collected and compiled by a sub-group of the GHSA Steering Group or a third party entity, such as a foundation.
 - a template provided to all GHSA members on a bi-annual basis to facilitate data collection by the Chair
 - Fill out the template, and need to provide relevant updates during subsequent data calls by partners.
- Develop two types of outputs:
 - an Annual Report on Commitments and Progress
 - Success stories to share publicly on the GHSA and other websites around the annual GHSA Ministerial meeting.
